# 2009 Acreage Count

- Last year 300,266 acres
  - NASS reported 300,000 acres in July.
  - FSA later reported 304,000 acres.
  - FSA then amended reports several months later to 300K acres saying “they used wrong data base”.
  - NASS needs to “amend” their final numbers; will do in September.

# 2009 Acreage Count

- 2008-09: 300,266
- 2009-10: 314,981
  - +14,714 acres
  - +4.9%

# 2009 Acreage Count

- Counted 151K fields
- Logged 3,201K acres
- Randomly audited 1.6% (59K acres)
- Accuracy = 99%
- Error range = (+ or -) 2,500 acres

# Implications for 2009-10

- At least 10,000 acres are Dehy contracted field run.
- The remaining 5,000 acres appear to be “open”.
- We have had an unprecedented effort to categorize all acres whether they are fresh, seed, contract dehy, or contract frozen.
